

Fire Safety and Safe Distances

- The hot tub must not be installed closer than 1 meter to building eaves or other flammable objects. The safe distance from the chimney to flammable materials is 3 meters.
- If there is a building or other flammable object nearby that could be affected by sparks, we recommend purchasing a spark arrestor, which is available as an additional accessory.
- The base for the stove should be constructed so that there is 40 cm of free space in front of the stove and 10 cm on the sides (see diagram).
- When installing a hot tub stove on a terrace, the stove must be placed in a safe location and protected from below and around the firebox with suitable fireproof materials.
- The stove's chimney and door become hot during heating, so caution should be exercised when bathing. The stove itself does not become hotter than the water temperature.
- For safety, ensure that the stove does not obstruct movement paths and that children cannot access the stove area.
- A spark arrestor, chimney extension, and heat shield are available as additional accessories for the stove chimney.
- Ask your local fire department for additional instructions on safely installing the hot tub.
- With the standard hoses provided, the stove is at a safe distance from the hot tub (0.8 m). If the hoses are shortened, we recommend installing a heat shield on the chimney (available as an accessory) to ensure safety.
